After meeting with the Warrensburg Parks and Recreation's Board of Directors, in hopes of soliciting support for an inclusive park, I have been asked to develop a basic plan and to determine the cost for a 2,500-3,000 square foot play pod.

The Warrensburg Parks and Recreation's Department would like to evaluate my basic plan and cost proposal before creating a Master Plan.

Johnson County Board of Services and Sheltered Workshop are county-wide agencies and will fundraise for inclusive play equipment to hold in reserve for use when the city completes its Master Plan. This reserve will not be limited to use in the City of Warrensburg. Criteria will be developed to allow local communities to partner with us for increasing playground inclusiveness.
