Recycling Guidelines

Plastic

- All plastic containers with the  symbol, numbers 1-7
 - Remove lids, empty contents, rinse container
- **NO:**
 - *Items without the  symbol*
 - *Styrofoam, plastic bags*
 - *Contaminated containers that are moldy or that held motor oil, pesticides, flammable liquids, etc.*
 - *Medical syringes, prescription bottles, veterinary supplies*

Paper (please sort by type)

- White office paper (regardless of ink color)
- Mixed paper: colored office paper, junk mail, envelopes, sticky notes, etc.
- Magazines
- Newspaper (including slick advertisements)
- Bagged shredded paper
- *NO wet or moldy paper*

Cardboard

- May be crushed or flattened
- Paper sacks
- Paperboard (cereal-type boxes; remove plastic liner)
- *NO wet, moldy cardboard OR cardboard contaminated with food, oil, mud, etc.*

Cans (aluminum and tin)

- Food cans, may leave labels
- Rinse
- *NO aerosol cans or those with food, oil, rust, etc.*

Glass

- Food/beverage containers only
- Any color
- *NO drinking glasses, window or picture frame glass, etc.*
